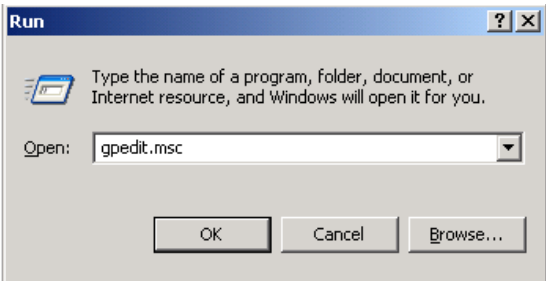




Ever get tired of the alert asking about why you want to reboot a Windows 2003 Server? This document describes the steps to disable Shutdown Event Tracker.



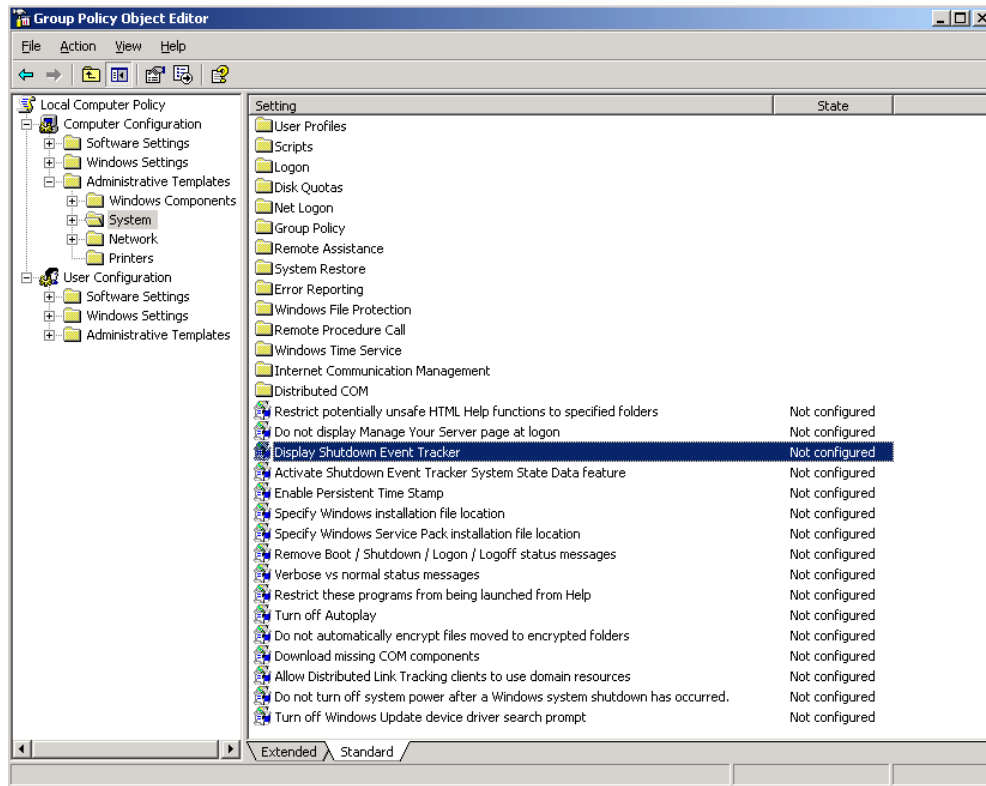
You can disable that feature with the "Group Policy Object Editor". Click on **Start - Run** and type **gpedit.msc**



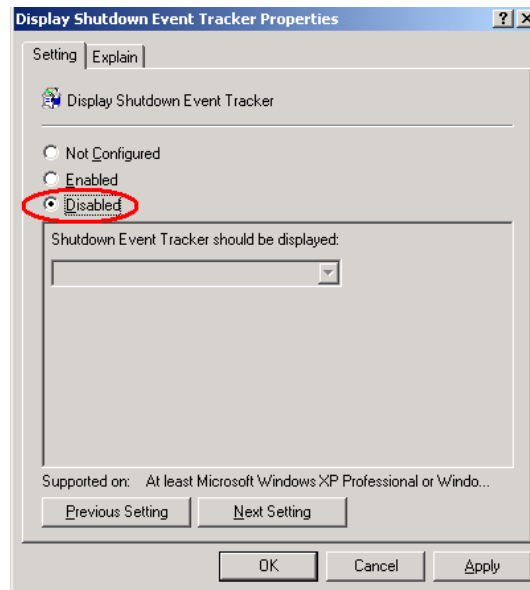
This will open the Group Policy Editor.

Click on Administrative Templates - System and search for "Display Shutdown Even Tracker"





Highlight "Display Shutdown Event Tracker" and right-click to see Properties.



Mark "Disabled" and click on Apply. That's it.
