




Reset Netscreen 5XP to factory default

The purpose of this document is to provide you with a short document to reset a NetScreen 5XP to factory default. It's not my intension to replace any official document or release notes. There are a couple ways to do this, but I like the straight forward to run this task on the terminal.


Connect NetScreen 5XP with provided console cable and start Terminal Program (9600-8-N-1)



```
Tera Term - COM1 VT
File Edit Setup Control Window Help

login: root
password:
ns5xp->
```

Type "unset all" console and press Enter, followed by the reset command.



```
Tera Term - COM1 VT
File Edit Setup Control Window Help


ns5xp-> unset all
Erase all system config, are you sure y/[n] ? y
ns5xp-> reset
Configuration modified, save? [y]/n n
System reset, are you sure? y/[n] y
In reset ...
```

The system will now reboot, and will be set to factory defaults.

Note: This procedure will also reset username and password to default

Default username: netscreen

Default password: netscreen
